The Supporting Recovery program offers:

- TRAUMA-INFORMED THERAPY: Traumainformed clinicians offer support for survivors
 of domestic, family and sexual violence.
 We will walk alongside you on your healing
 journey by providing you with support and
 information around your options for care.
- + **REFERRAL SERVICES:** Warm referrals to legal, financial, and housing support services.
- Social and emotional wellbeing and mental health support.
- **CULTURALLY SAFE:** Creating a safe space for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, as well as all community members, to heal with the support of trauma-informed workers and clinicians.
- **FLEXIBLE ACCESS:** The program is offered at locations across the Central Coast, as well as online and over the phone.

Experiencing family, domestic, or sexual violence can have long-lasting effects on your mental health and wellbeing. Supporting Recovery provides free, traumainformed support across Greater Newcastle.



Our Local Care Team will coordinate and manage your care as part of your healing journey, offering mental health and trauma-informed care, along with group work, play therapies, counselling, and cultural practices that support the whole family.



Our therapies provide a **safe space** that supports and empowers **men**, **women**, **and children** on their path to recovery.

What can you expect?

You'll work closely with a member of our Local Care Team. Together, you'll create a recovery plan that respects your choices and needs and connects you with tailored mental health and therapy services. We offer a safe, understanding environment – whether in person or online – so you feel supported every step of the way.

What does it cost?

This service is offered to community members in the Newcastle, Lake Macquarie and Port Stephens areas, at no cost, for up to two years.

About supporting recovery

Supporting Recovery is a pilot program funded by the Hunter New England and Central Coast Primary Health Network. It provides tailored healing and recovery support for individuals, families, and children impacted by domestic, family, and sexual violence.
