## What does Family Dispute Resolution do?

Family Dispute Resolution (FDR) is a special type of mediation for helping separating families to come to their own agreements in relation to child care / custody arrangements, separation of assets in a divorce.

During FDR families will discuss the issues in dispute and consider different options while being encouraged to focus on the needs of their children.
